### Bulky Waste Items NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** Batteries
- NO** Building or Demolition Debris
- NO** Commercial, Dump Truck or Loader Tires
- NO** Garbage or Household Trash
- NO** Gas Tanks or Containers
- NO** Hazardous or Liquid Waste
- NO** Household Cleaners/Insecticides
- NO** Household Recyclables
- NO** Lightbulbs
- NO** Paints
- NO** Propane Tanks
- NO** Shingles
- NO** Yard or Tree Waste

**Any power equipment needs to be drained of all liquids: no oil and no gas allowed.**

**All Refrigerators, Air Conditioners & Dehumidifiers must be drained of all freon. The Town has acquired a company to remove the freon. The cost is \$10 per unit, please bring cash or check payable to the Town of Durham.**
